Dear Florida ARF Member:

In January 2007, Governor Crist signed legislation enabling certain nonprofits to be eligible for pooling insurance risks. As a result of that legislation, the Florida Insurance Trust (FIT) was formed and began operations in early June 2007.

Florida ARF has offered several insurance companies the opportunity to present their concepts for taking advantage of the pooling of risks authorized by this legislation and to date, none have seriously responded except one. We have since learned that FIT is currently the only organization doing business in this arena in Florida.

FIT will provide the following types of insurance (you may pick and choose the types of coverage desired) at reduced costs while maintaining or improving current levels of coverage:

- **Worker's Compensation**
- **Property**
- **General Liability**
- **Commercial Auto**
- **Professional Liability**
- **Directors & Officers Liability**

We are working with FIT to bring them aboard as an Allied Partner because of our strong belief that this program will bring you bottom line results. After several meetings with FIT's leadership and background investigation, we are convinced that this program is a credible and viable option for obtaining relief from rising insurance costs for our members and RESPECT Employment Centers. We have arranged for FIT to have a presence at our upcoming Annual Meeting in September so you will have the opportunity for face-to-face interaction.
